INVITATION FOR BID

The United Keetoowah Band is soliciting bids from contractors for office space flooring located in Tahlequah. Bid packages can be requested via email to fsmith@ukb-nsn.gov or by phone 918-871-2768. The bid is open 7/1/2024 and will close on 7/30/2024 at 4:00pm. Bids can be emailed to fsmith@ukb-nsn.gov. The bid will be dated, and time stamped once received.

Bidders are urged to inspect the site where services are to be performed and to satisfy themselves as to all general and local conditions that may affect the cost of performance of the contract to the extent such information is reasonably obtainable. In no event will a failure to inspect the site constitute grounds for withdrawal of a bid after opening or constitute grounds for a claim after contract award. Site visits can be arranged at fsmith@ukb-nsn.gov.

The UKB intends to award to the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder whose bid does not exceed the amount of funds the Transit Department determines to be available for the project, a fixed price contract furnishing all materials, equipment, labor, and supervision required for completion of the work set out in this solicitation and contract documents.

All contractors must be able to be insured. Contracts shall not be awarded to debarred, suspended, or ineligible contractors. Contractors must comply with the Davis-Bacon Act, Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act, as supplemented in Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR part 3).

The UKB reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities or irregularities in any bid, solicit new bids, or proceed to do the work by other means as may be determined in the best interest of the United Keetoowah Band.

The UKB shall apply Indian preference when applicable. UKB shall give preference in procurement activities consistent with the requirements of section 7(b) of the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C. 450e (b), when applicable.
